#### **Directions for use**

#### **IMPORTANT**

Before using Sealocrete Sealotone Powder Cement Colours refer to the relevant Health & Safety Data Sheet, available at www.sealocrete.com.

- 1. Add the required amount of Sealocrete Sealotone to the dry cement, sand and aggregate. Before adding any liquid, mix well until colour is thoroughly dispersed.
- To obtain colours in cement and concrete, a ratio of 1 part colour to 20 parts cement by weight should be
- 3. Alternative shades can be obtained by varying the amount of Sealocrete Sealotone added to the cement. The ratio should never exceed 1 part Sealocrete Sealotone to 10 parts cement by weight.
- 4. To obtain best results and reduce efflorescence use sharp washed sand only.
- The use of Sealocrete Sealotone with Sealocrete Sealoproof or Sealocrete Sealotak SBR is recommended.
- 6. Test a trial area first to assess colour stability once dry. Minor colour variations can occur between batches.
- 7. To ensure colour consistency, use product from the same batch number.

#### Cleaning

1. Clean tools and equipment immediately after use with water.
